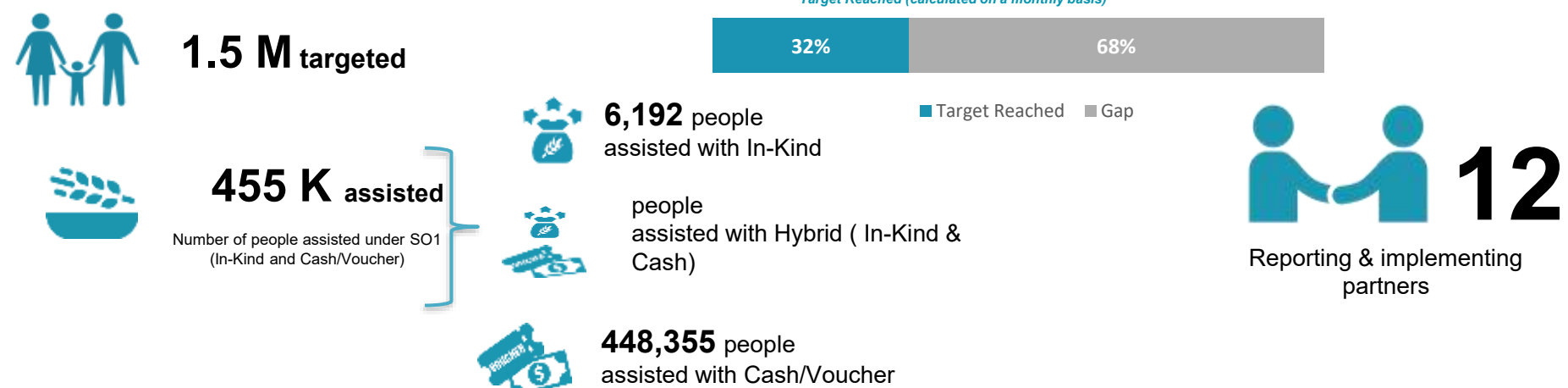




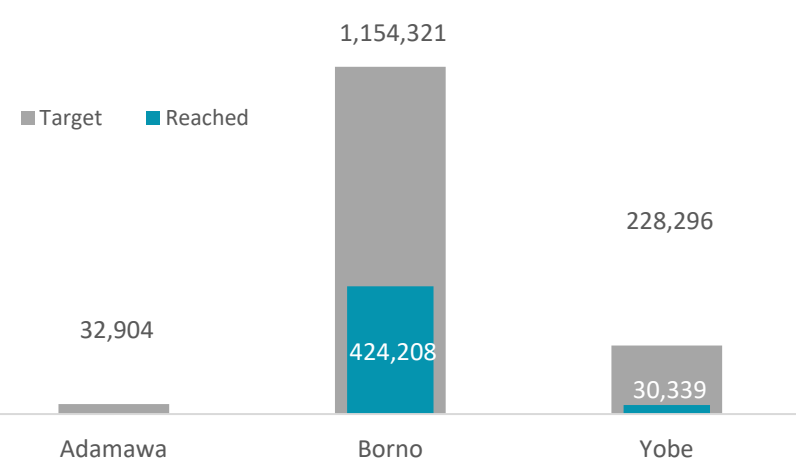

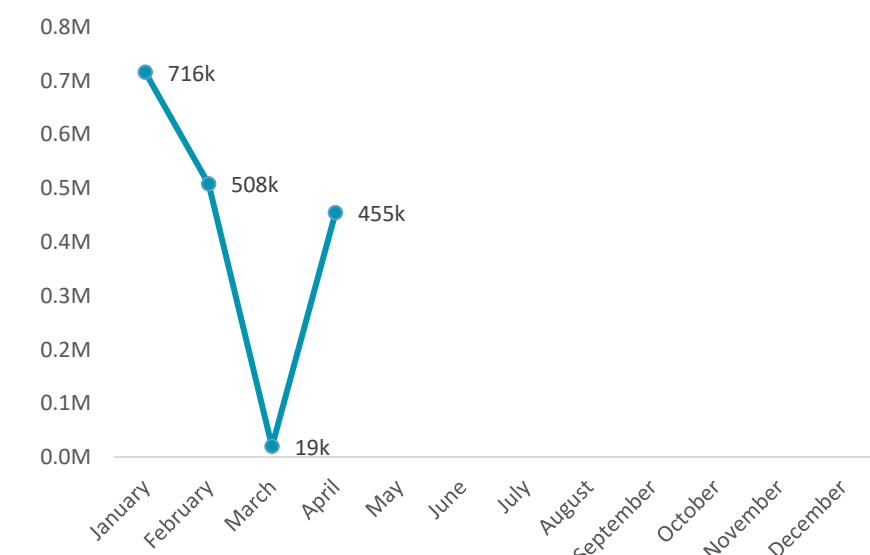
Narrative

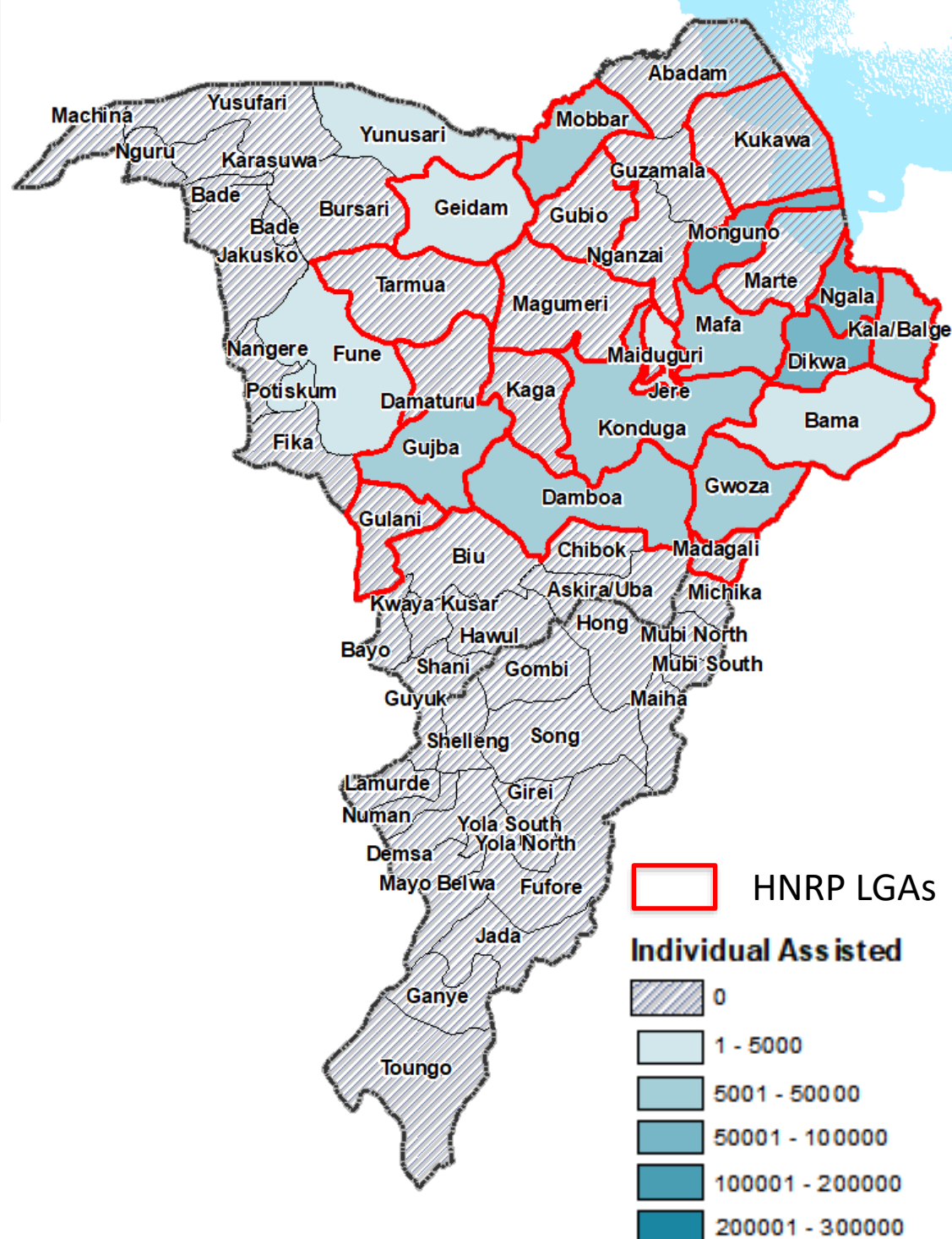
Response by State



Monthly Response Monitoring (trend)



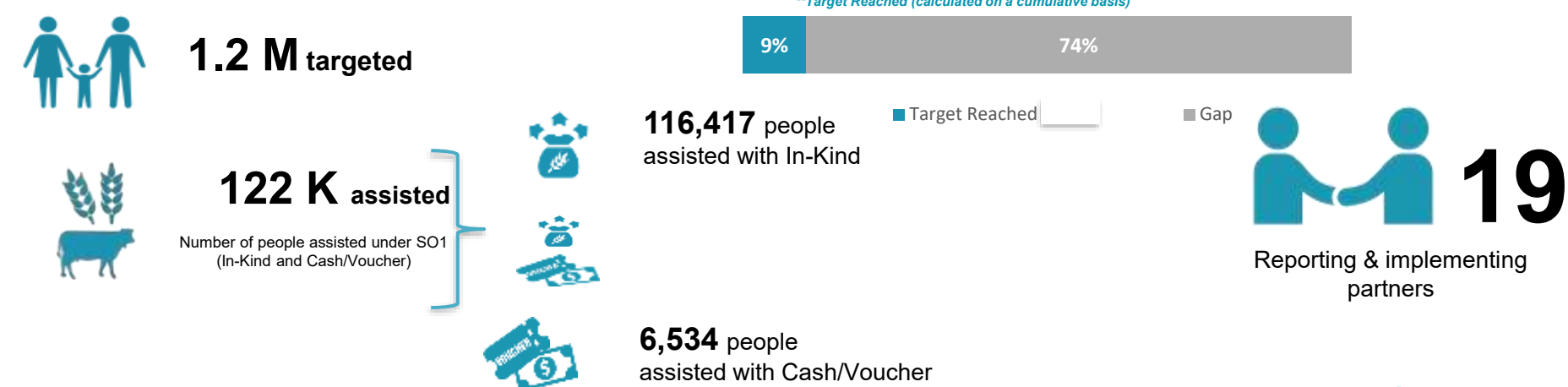
Response Map

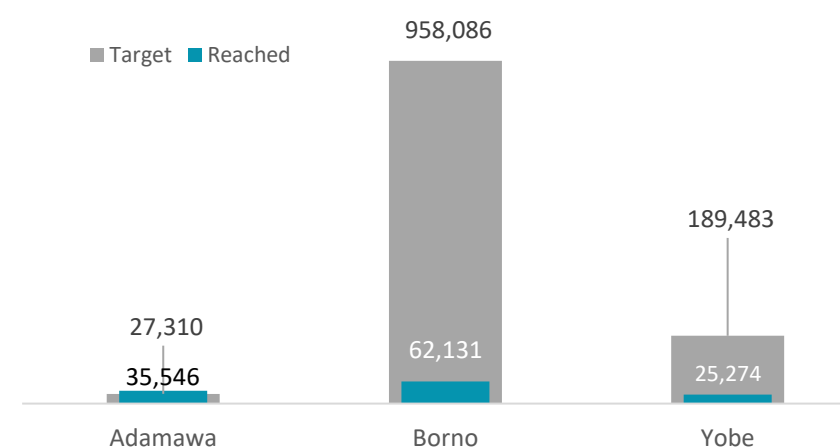

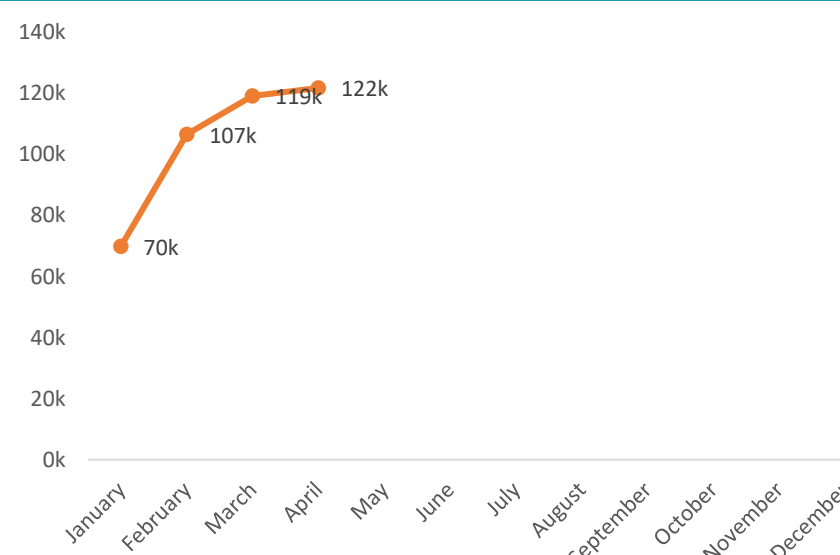
Narrative

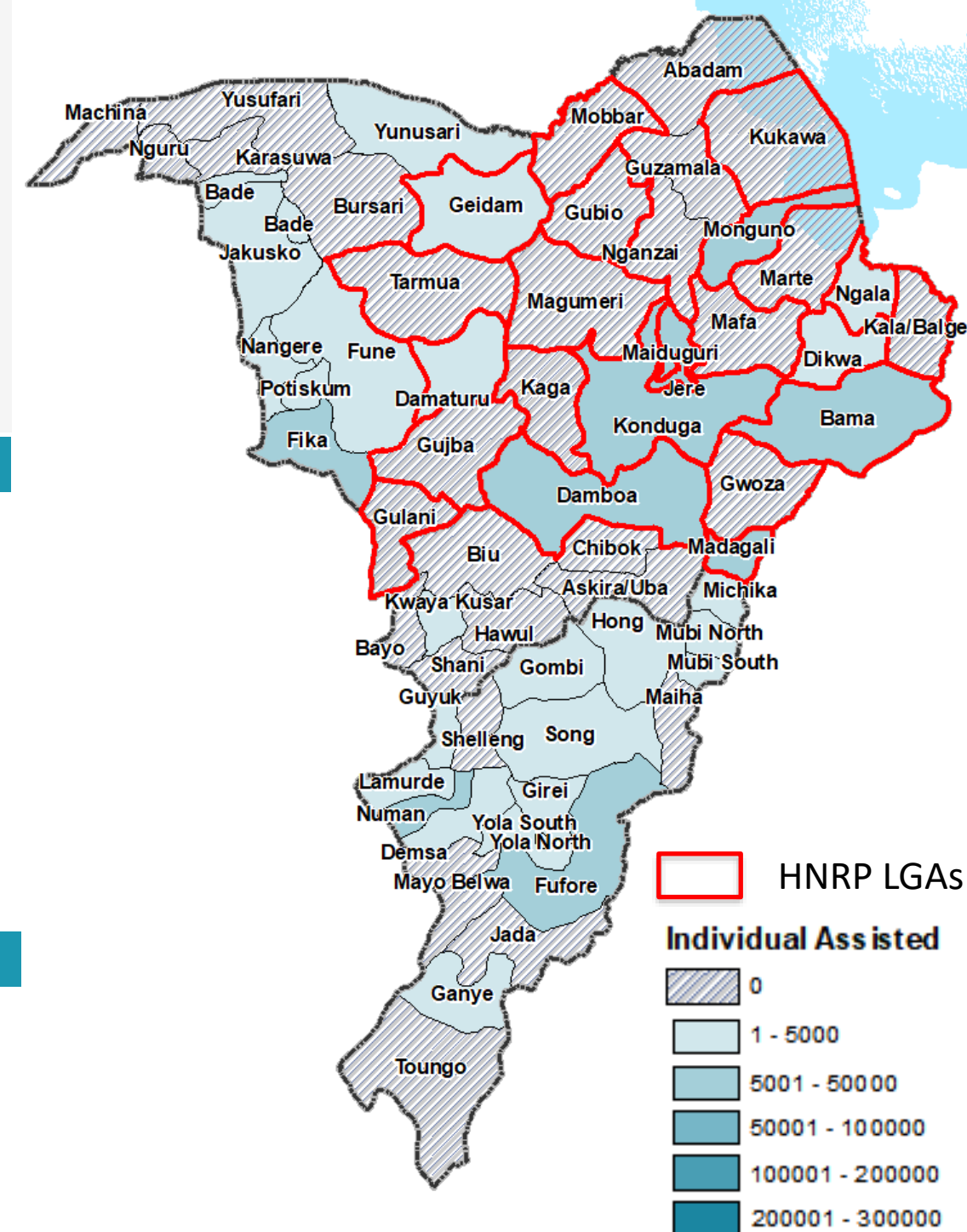
Response by State
