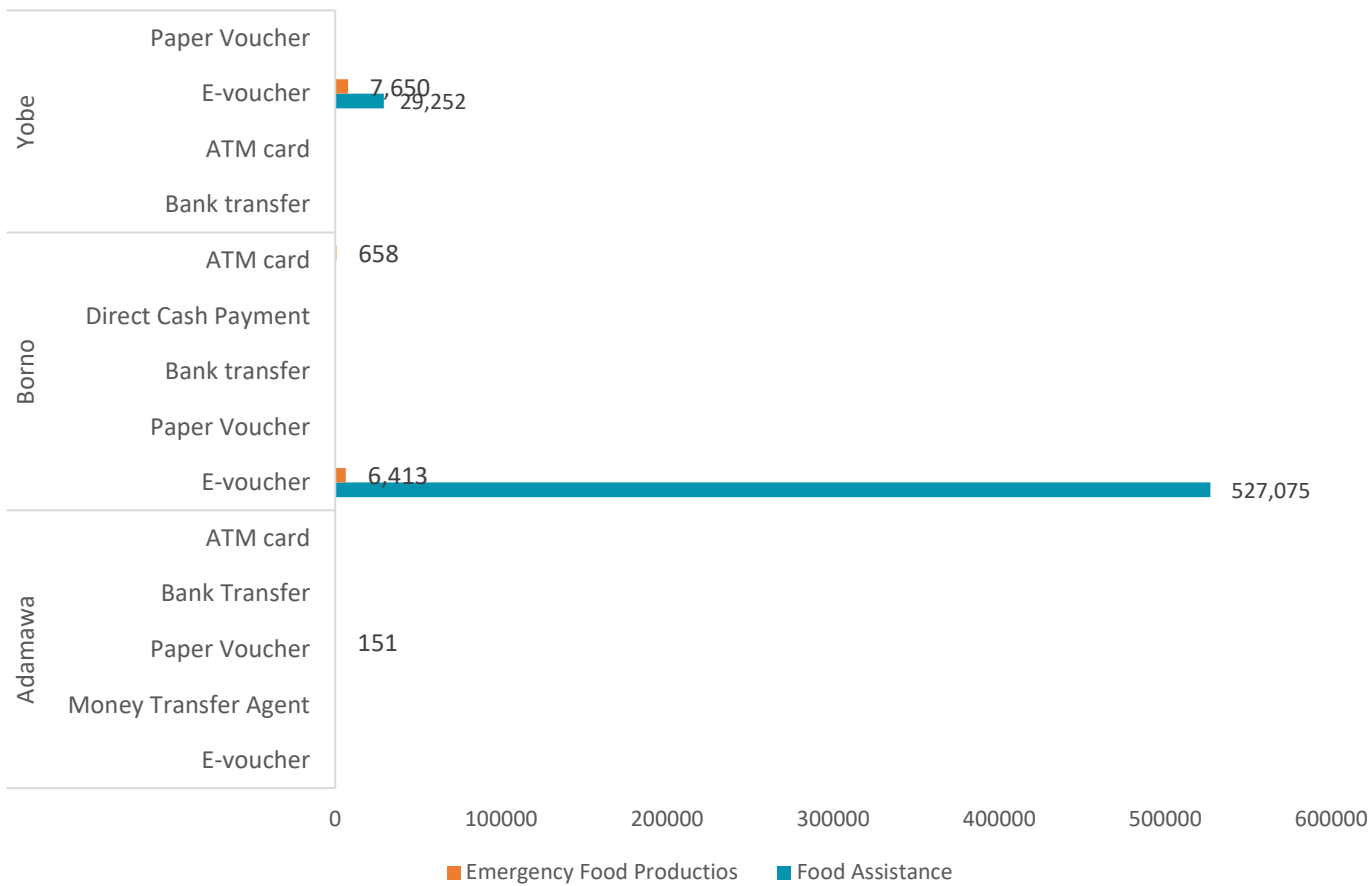
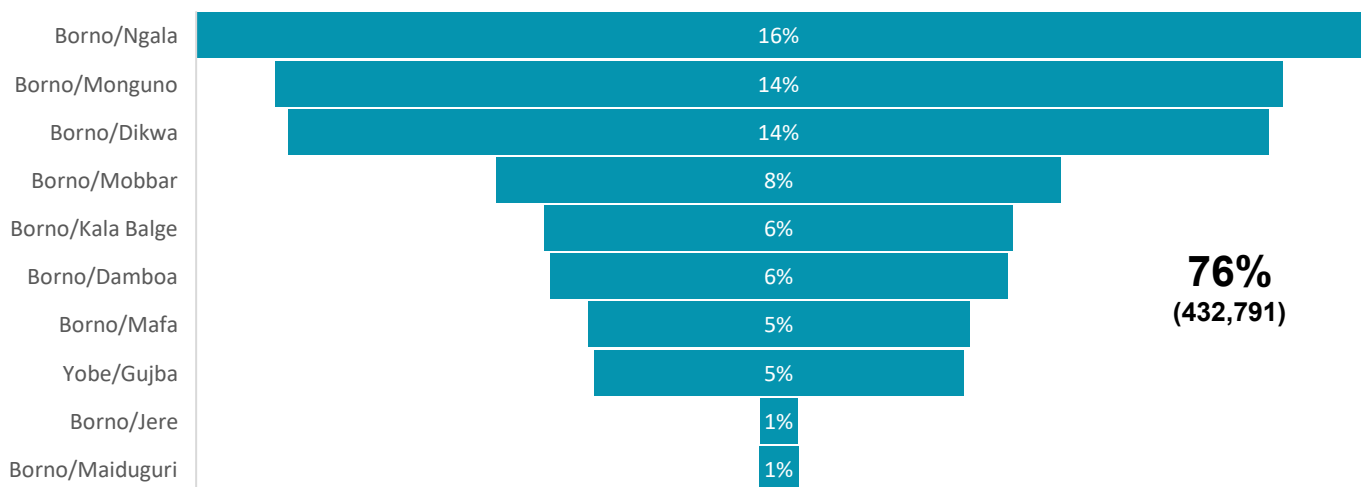


The food security sector assisted 559,171 people with food assistance and around 164,704 people with agriculture and livelihoods. 99 percent (556,327) received food assistance in cash or vouchers (CVA) and 9 percent (14,872) received emergency agriculture and on-farm livelihood support either through cash or in-kind (hybrid). A total of 13 organizations, national, and international non-governmental organizations, and UN agencies used various delivery mechanisms such as cash payments, mobile money transfers, paper vouchers, and electronic vouchers. Borno state accounts for 94 percent, Yobe state accounts for 6 percent of the CVA beneficiaries.

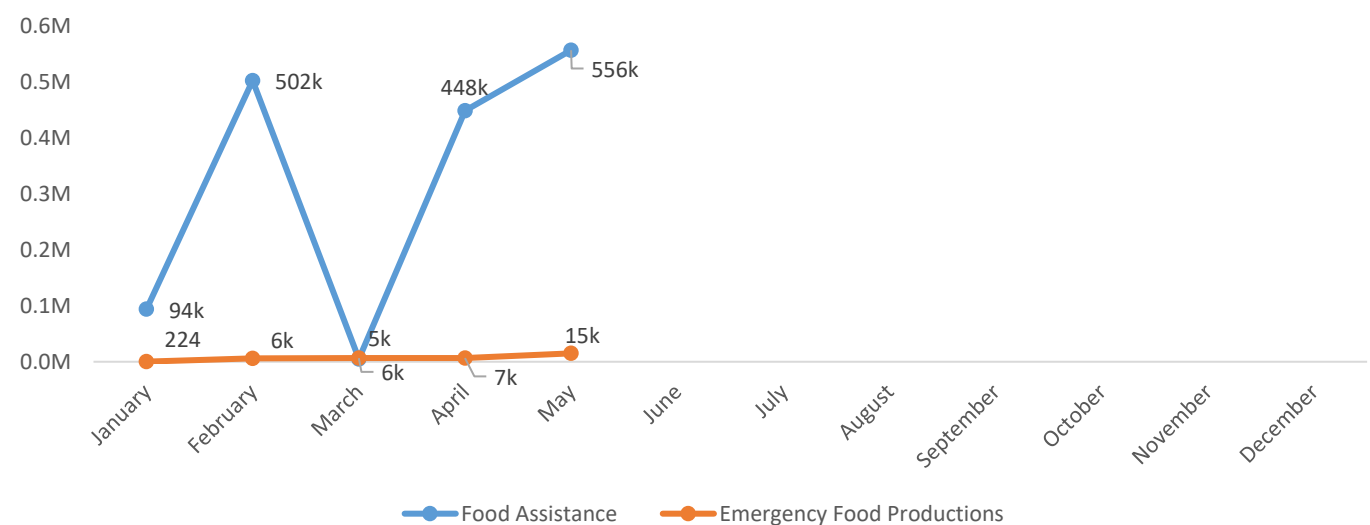
Cash Voucher Assistance (CVA) Modalities use by State



Top 10 LGAs with CVA



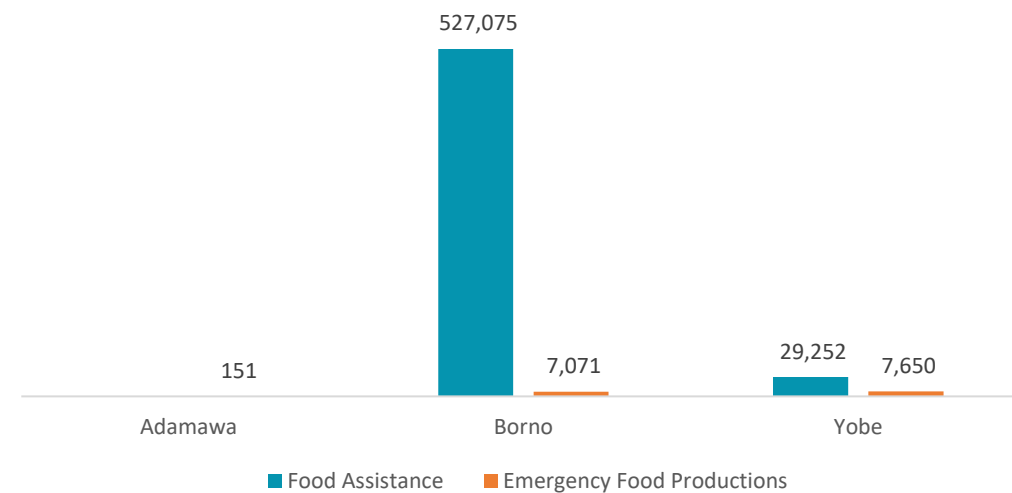
Monthly Response Monitoring (trend)



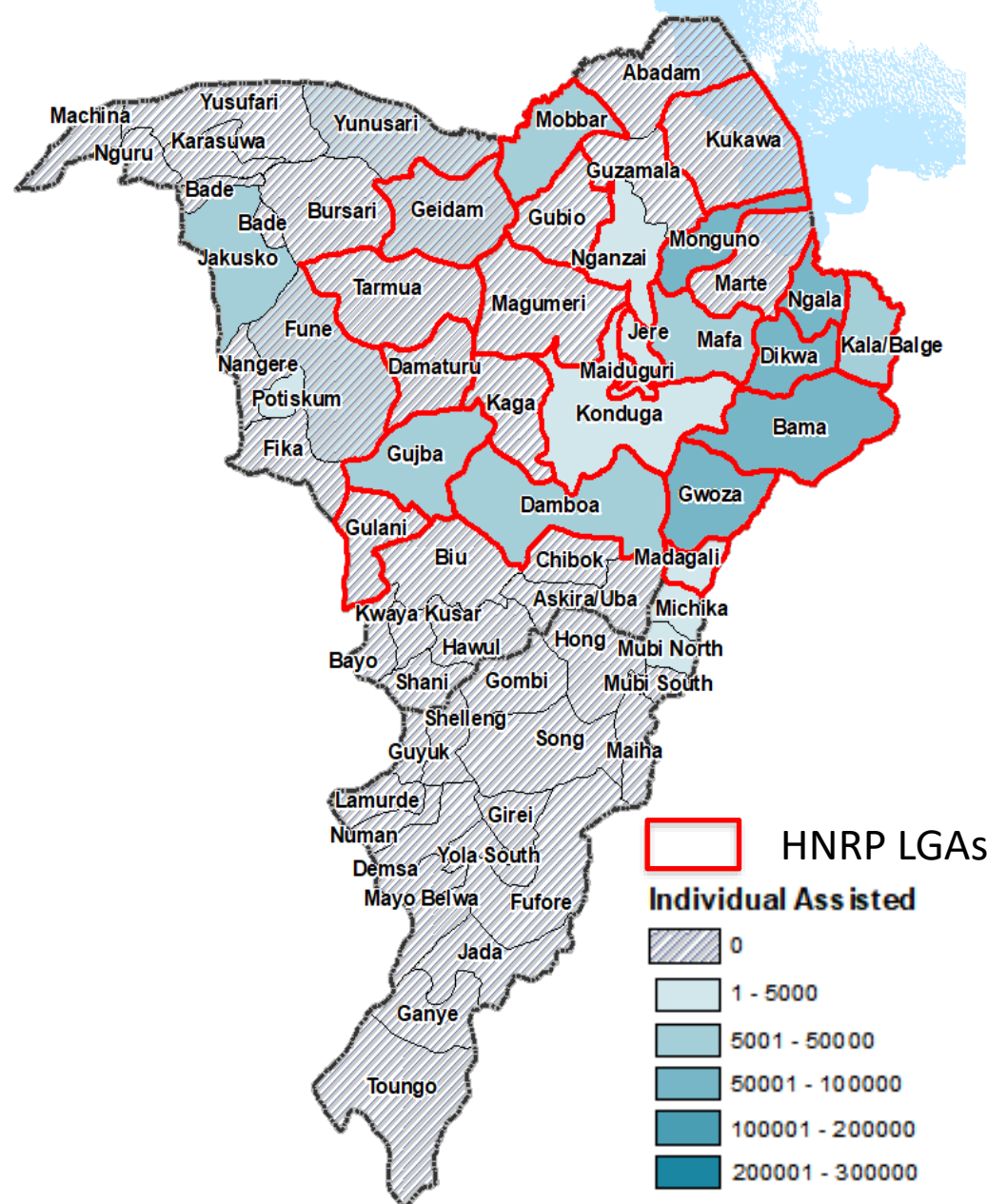
Keys figures - Cash monitoring

Response Map



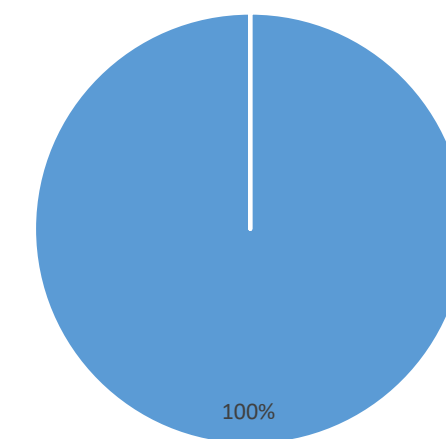

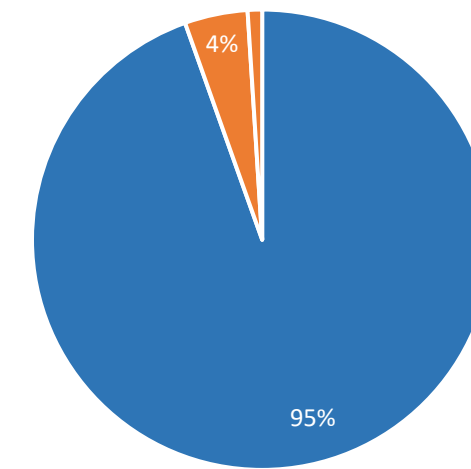

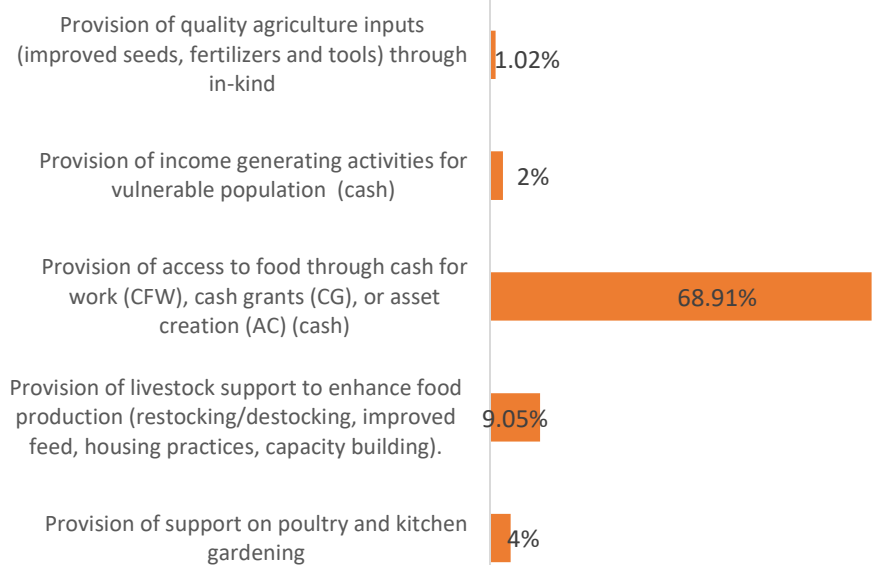
