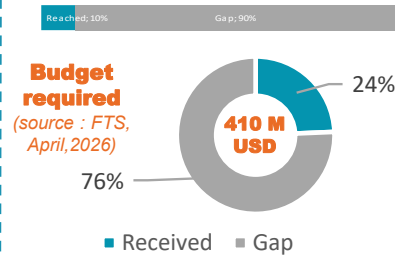
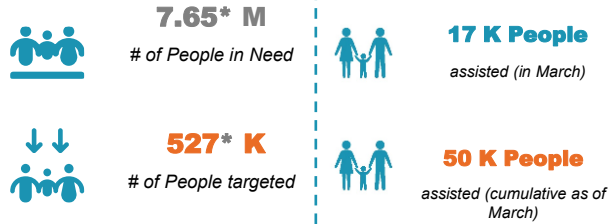
Cluster objective 3: Provide access to nutritious food especially for vulnerable women and children through own production.

Food Security Situation in South Sudan

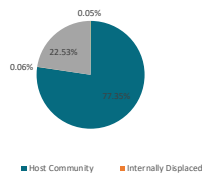
- Estimated 7.65 million People in Need of urgent humanitarian assistance and protection in 2026.
- Within this period, 28,000 people in Luakpiny/Nasir (17,000) and Fangak (11,000) are projected to remain in IPC Phase 5 (Catastrophe), while approximately 1.45 million people will likely remain in IPC Phase 4 (Emergency). The most food insecure states between December 2025 and March 2026 include Upper Nile (57 percent) and Unity (56 percent).
- During the first projection period December 2025 to March 2026, 14 counties are expected to be in IPC Phase 4, 50 counties in IPC A Phase 3, and 15 counties in IPC Phase 2 (Stressed). Kapoeta East and North (Eastern Equatoria) and Rubkona (Unity) counties are expected to deteriorate from IPC Phase 3 to IPC Phase 4. Meanwhile Twic East is expected to improve from IPC Phase 4 to IPC Phase 3 and Tambura to improve from IPC Phase 3 to IPC Phase 2.

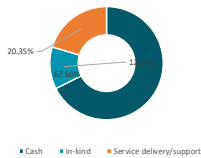

By Beneficiary Type



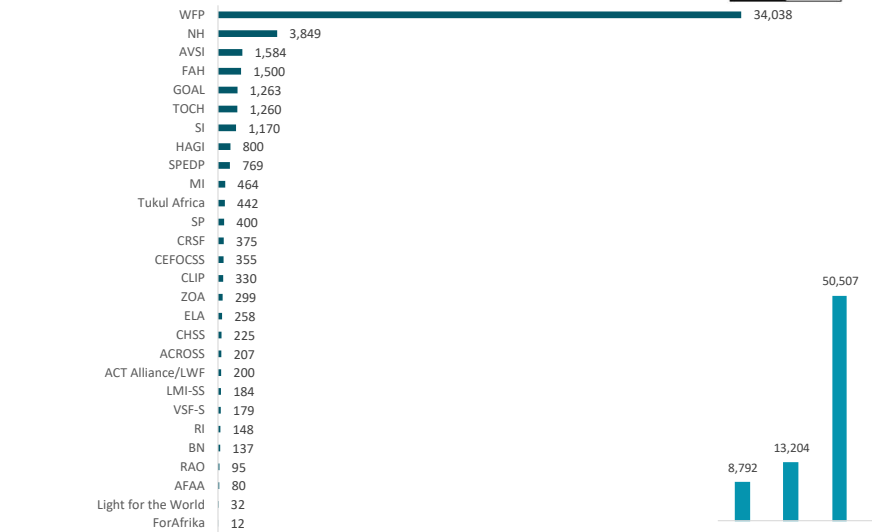
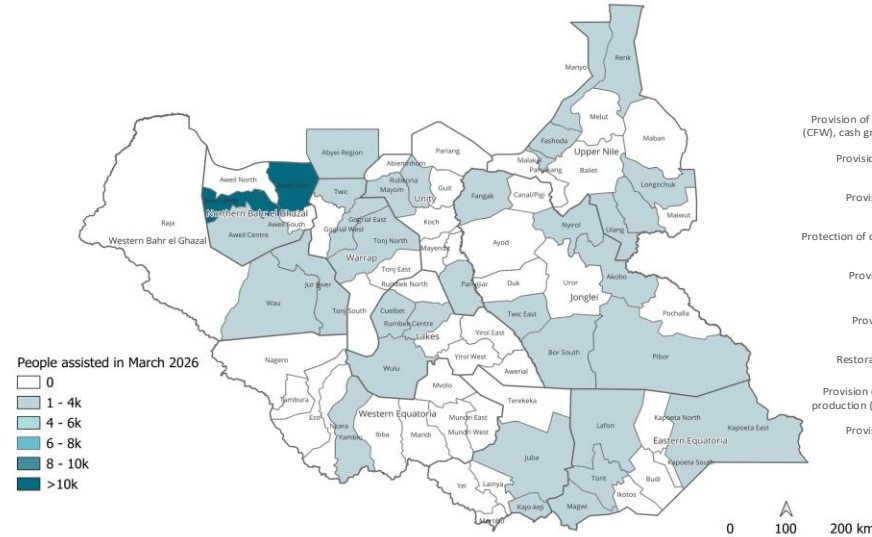

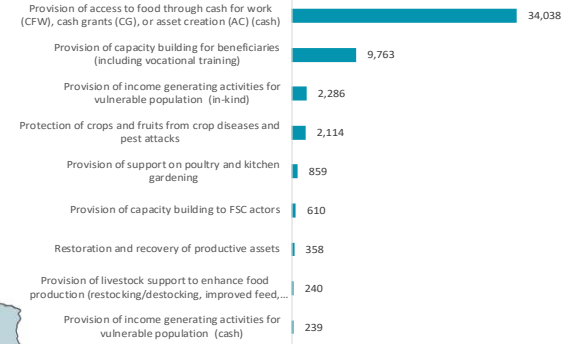

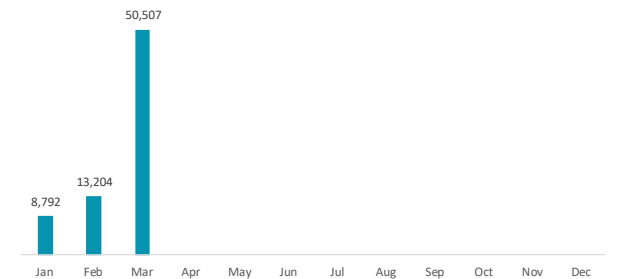
